Reference: "Click It or Ticket" Seat Belt Enforcement

Last month (from May 14 through May 31) the Kane County Sheriff's Office, along with more than 500 other Illinois law enforcement agencies, participated in the national "Click It or Ticket" Seat Belt Enforcement Mobilization. The increased enforcement was made possible by a grant from the Illinois Department of Transportation Division of Traffic Safety.

During the mobilization 108 safety belt citations, 6 child safety seat citations, 5 uninsured motorist citations, and 10 speeding citations were written. In addition 2 drivers were arrested for suspended or revoked license, 1 felony arrest and 1 drug arrest was made, and one subject was arrested on an outstanding warrant. A special emphasis was placed on seat belt enforcement at night, when the risk of a fatal crash increases significantly.

The Sheriff's Office reminds everyone to always buckle up; not only is it the law, it also saves lives.
