SYNOPSIS

Kane County Sheriff Pat Perez is announcing the capture of one of the Kane County Sheriff's Office 10 most wanted fugitives.

Kane County Sheriff's Deputies were notified that on 7/7/2010 Michael Keenan was taken into custody in Wauwatosa, Wi and transported to the Waukesha County Sheriff's Office. On 7/9/2010 Kane County Sheriff's Deputies picked him up and transported him back to Kane County. Keenan was wanted in connection with a 2007 home invasion in the City of Geneva. Keenan had three warrants:

- Home Invasion
- Domestic Battery
- Violation of Bail Bond

Keenan is being held at the Kane Count Adult Justice Center. His bond is \$875,000 and he will appear at bond call at the Kane County Sheriff's Office on 7/10/2010 at approximately 8:30am.

The charges against Keenan are not a proof of guilt. A defendant is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his or her guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
