Incident: Fatal Vehicle vs. Bicycle Crash

### **SYNOPSIS**

On 6/27/12 at approximately 2:15 pm Kane County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to the area of Nelson Lark Rd south of Main St in Batavia Township for a report of a car versus bicycle traffic crash.

The initial investigation indicates that a bicycle was traveling north on Nelson Lake Rd near the entrance to the Dick Young Forest Preserve. There was a line of cars that was also traveling north on Nelson Lake Rd. Several of the cars swerved to go around the bicycle that was riding on the side of the roadway. A 2009 Nissan Rogue was traveling north in the line of cars failed to go around the bicycle a struck the rear tire of the bicycle. This caused the bicyclist to be thrown from the bicycle.

The bicyclist was transported to Mercy Center Hospital in Aurora where he was pronounced deceased. He was not wearing a helmet but appeared to have been wearing headphones at the time of the crash.

The driver of the Nissan was uninjured and was issued a ticket for failure to reduce speed to avoid an accident.

Kane County Sheriff's Detectives and members of the Kane Count Accident Reconstruction Team are continuing to investigate the cause of this crash. The investigation has not determined if drugs, alcohol or texting were a factor in this crash.

Driver, and sole occupant of the Nissan, MaMaxima Corazona Cardino Ty a female with a date of birth of 2/28/87 who resides in the 2100 block of Howard St in Evanston Il.

Bicyclist Richard White 50 years of age of the 1400 block of Fechner Cr. in North Aurora Il.

Nelson Lake Rd was closed for approximately 3 hours while the crash was investigated.
