I am pleased to announce that my office will be hosting an Advanced Elderly Service Officer (ESO) class for certified ESOs in Illinois. The half-day class will be held on September 25, 2019, at the Concord Place Retirement Community – Midwest Conference Center in Northlake. This class will be held in conjunction with the Illinois TRIAD conference.

The Advanced ESO class is intended for law enforcement officers who have previously attended the basic ESO Training course. This class will build upon previous training by providing in-depth information on topics often addressed by Elderly Service Officers.

This year's Advanced ESO focuses on Working with Seniors Experiencing Homelessness. This training will teach law enforcement officers how confidently and compassionately manage problem behavior of homeless, addicted, mentally ill and traumatized seniors. Additionally, the training will include a discussion of new resources for ESOs.
