

GUIDELINES FOR POSTING BOND

Once a detainee has been processed (booked) into the Kane County Adult Justice Center, he/she can be “bonded out” and released from custody if a bond amount has been set. These guidelines inform you of what is needed before you come to the facility

- Call the Kane County Adult Justice Center at 630-208-2083, to confirm the person you want to bond out is in custody.

- The Corrections Officers are not allowed to accept personal checks or money orders. Officers will only accept cash or credit cards.

- You must also have the bond fee (\$46.00 per charge) prior to your arrival at the facility. It is important that you have the exact amount, as the Officers cannot make change. This fee must also be paid by cash or credit card only.

*Now that you have the bond money and bond fee, you should call the facility again at the number above to confirm that the detainee is still in custody. When you call, tell the Officer that you have the bond money and are ready to come to the facility. Ask the Officer what would be the best time to post bond.

*If it has been more than twenty-four (24) hours since you last called, please call the facility again to confirm that the detainee is still in custody.
