**Requirements Include:**

- Must be currently employed as a full-time law enforcement officer in a Sheriff's Department, Police Department, or other law enforcement agency with at least one (1) year of experience with the present agency
- Possess a Certificate from a certified police training academy that complies with the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board
- Must possess proof of successful completion of P.O.W.E.R. Test administered within five (5) years before Oral Interview with the Merit Commission
- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Possess a valid Driver's License, and be a United States Citizen
- Must possess a valid FOID card
- Pass background investigation, polygraph, and psych test
- Eyesight corrected to 20/20, be free of color blindness
- Must pass an Oral Interview with the Merit Commission

**Oral interviews will be held on October 17, beginning at 4:30 at the Merit Commission Office.**

**Benefits**

- Upon hire, the deputy will begin with "Completion of Year 2" for starting pay (\$75,901).
- Upon completion of field training, the deputy will have one (1) week of vacation benefit time for use if hired after June 1<sup>st</sup> of the fiscal year (to be used during the fiscal year of hired) and two (2) weeks of vacation benefit time for use if hired before June 1<sup>st</sup> of the fiscal year (to be used during the fiscal year of hire).
- Full health, dental, and eye insurance. Two-month stipend provided to cover Kane County health insurance policy gap.
