THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MUST BE RETURNED WITH YOUR APPLICATION

1. Copy of a valid Driver's License
2. Copy of your Birth Certificate (It must be a copy as it is not returnable.)
3. Copy of your High School diploma, G.E.D., or transcripts
4. Passport-size photo
5. **COPY of (P.O.W.E.R CARD) State of IL Police Officer Wellness Evaluation through NIPSTA, Joliet Junior College, Triton College, or other physical testing facility.**
Must have proof of P.O.W.E.R CARD prior to test.
6. Copy of your FOID CARD
7. If Honorably Discharged, include a copy of your DD-214
7. Educational points: if applicable, include a copy of a college diploma

REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

- Be 21 at the time of appointment (no upper age limit restrictions)
- Be a citizen of the United States for one year
- Have no felony convictions
- Eyesight correctable to 20/20 vision, free from color blindness
- Be a resident of Illinois living within 75 miles of the Kane County seat, Geneva, IL
- Pass polygraph exam, psychological testing, and background check
- Possess a valid Driver's License
- Must pass the written test at 65% or better
- In addition, a physical exam will be required before being hired

A valid driver's license must be presented at the exam.

No one will be allowed to enter the building after 5:30 pm.

Please note: If you have previously failed the background check from the Kane County psychological exam or a polygraph exam within the past year, your application will not be accepted.
