### **Requirements Include:**

- Must be currently employed as a full-time law enforcement officer in a Sheriff's Department, Police Department, or other law enforcement agency with at least 18 Months of experience with present agency
- Possess a Certificate from a certified police training academy that complies with the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board
- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Possess a valid Driver's License, and be a United States Citizen
- Must possess a valid FOID card
- Pass background investigation, polygraph and psych test
- Eyesight corrected to 20/20, be free of color blindness
- Must pass an Oral Interview with the Merit Commission

### **Benefits**

- Upon hire, \$82,095 (Completion of Year 2) and after successful completion of FTO \$88,715 (Completion of Year 3 Pay.)  
Top out \$104,036. December 1, 2024, will start a new contract and pay scale TBD.
- Laterals with 5+ years of full-time experience will be on an accelerated pay scale. Upon successful completion of a 10 week FTO \$100,390 (Completion of Year 5 Pay.) After 1 year probation \$104,036 (Completion of Year 6 Pay).
- Upon completion of field training, the deputy will have one (1) week of vacation benefit time for use if hired after June 1<sup>st</sup> of the fiscal year (to be used during the fiscal year hired) and two (2) weeks of vacation benefit time for use if hired prior to June 1<sup>st</sup> of the fiscal year (to be used during the fiscal year of hire)
- Full health, dental and eye insurance. Two-month stipend provided to cover Kane County health insurance policy gap.
